This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 11.08.2020 vide which neither the appellant nor the respondent was present.

2. The perusal of the file shows that the respondent is absent for fourth consecutive hearing. He has not even bothered to inform the Commission about his absence. The respondent has not filed a reply of show cause notice issued on 01.06.2020, which shows that the respondent-PIO has no regard for the orders issued by the Commission. This is very serious matter.

3. In view of the foregoing, Respondent- PIO is directed to show cause in writing or through affidavit under Section 20(1) of the RTI Act:-

- (i) Why supply of information as per RTI request sent to him has been delayed.
- (ii) Why penalty be not imposed upon him for not supplying the information within time as prescribed under RTI Act 2005.
- (iii) Why appellant should not be compensated for the harassment and financial loss suffered by him in getting the information.

- (ii) Why penalty be not imposed upon him for not supplying the information within time as prescribed under RTI Act 2005.

ORDERS

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 11.08.2020 vide which last opportunity was given to the PIO, o/o MTP, M.C Moga to file reply of show cause notice issued.

2. Brief facts of the case are that the appellant filed his RTI on 06.05.2019. On not receiving the information, he has filed First appeal with the First Appellate Authority on 12.06.2019 and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 20.09.2019 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued for 21.11.2019.

3. On 21.11.2019, no one appeared on behalf of the respondent, accordingly the appeal was adjourned on 16.12.2019. On 16.12.2019, the appellant was absent. However, Sh. Gautam Kumar, appeared on behalf of the respondent and stated that the information has already been sent to the appellant. On 07.01.2020, the appellant stated that incomplete information has been given to him , hence inspection rights were given to the appellant and Sh. Kamalpreet Singh, Draftsman appearing on behalf of the Respondent was directed to provide complete information to the appellant. Accordingly the appeal was adjourned on 10.02.2020. On hearings dated 10.02.2020, 12.03.2020, 15.06.2020, 11.08.2020, no one appeared on behalf of the Respondent. On 11.08.2020, a

show cause notice was issued to the respondent –PIO and the appeal was adjourned on 07.10.2020 i.e. today.

4. Today, again the respondent is not present. It is observed that neither the respondent has bothered to attend the hearings nor has he filed a reply to the show cause notice issued to him. This shows that the respondent-PIO has no regard for the orders issued by the Commission. This amounts to complete neglect of their duty under the RTI regime. The RTI Act 2005 was enacted with a view to promote transparency and accountability in the working of public authorities so that the corruption in the working of government is contained and the government and its instrumentalities are held accountable to the people.

5. In view of the above mentioned circumstances, Respondent-PIO, O/o Municipal Town Planner, Municipal Corporation, Moga is responsible for the delay in providing the information and harassment suffered by the Appellant.

6. The Commission is constrained to observe that a large number of officers have failed to appreciate the spirit of the Act for promotion of openness in their functioning. Respondent may note that the RTI Act 2005 is meant for promoting transparency in governmental functioning by bringing to light governmental actions done behind closed doors so that the common man is kept well informed of the goings on in the public authorities with a view to strengthening democracy. The RTI Act 2005 is not to be used as a substitute for availing of services available under various statutes for matters not involving the bringing to light the mannerism of / flaws in the working of public authority.

7. In the backdrop of the aforementioned factual position, initiation of action under Section 20(1) Right to Information Act, 2005, against the respondent-PIO called for. I am, therefore, left with no other option but to decide the question of imposition of *penalty upon Respondent-PIO, O/o MTP, Municipal Corporation, Moga of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand only).* The amount of penalty i.e. Rs. 10,000/- should be

deducted from the salary of Respondent-PIO and be deposited in the Government treasury under head 0070-Other Administrative Services-60-Other Services-800-Other Receipts-86-Fees under the Right to Information Act.

The Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Moga shall ensure that this amount of penalty is deducted from the salary of the above said PIO and deposited in the Treasury under the relevant head.
