**ORDER**

1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 06.10.2022 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing.
2. The case has been heard today in the Commission's office at Chandigarh. Smt. Rajni, appellant comes present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench.
3. Shri Satish Sharma, DSP, Nangal and ASI Sardool Singh, come present in person before the Bench. Shri Sardul Singh states that point-wise information has been supplied to the appellant and also clarifies to the appellant the issues raised by the appellant before the Bench.
4. The Appellant, Ms. Rajni shows her dissatisfaction and states that she has not been apprised of the reasons for conducting a raid on her house without any complaint against her and also narrates the high handedness on the part of the officials of Police Station, Nangal.
4. Post deliberation, the Bench observes that requisite information stands supplied to the appellant. As regards her grievance regarding property dispute with her husband's elder brother as also against the officials of Police Station, Nangal who had conducted raid at the house of appellant without any reason whose names have been mentioned by the appellant as ASI Balram, Constable Kanta and another Police official Gurmail Singh, the Bench directs the DSP Nangal who is present in the Court, to look into the matter, the appellant being a widow, sympathetic view be taken and the grievance of the appellant be resolved. He is also directed to ensure that three officials also come present in person before the Bench on the next date of hearing.

5. As the appellant still expresses her dis-satisfaction over the information supplied, the PIO O/o SSP Roopnagar is directed to again provide point information to the appellant, particularly explaining position regarding the points on registration of FIR and the departure of Police party after conduct raid on the residence of appellant, as has been stated by Shri Satish Sharma, DSP, Nangal before the Bench .

6. With the aforesaid directions, the matter is adjourned. **To come up for hearing on 05.12.2022 at 11.30 AM before the Bench in Commission's office at Chandigarh.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
