The RTI request is dated 15.10.2018. First appeal is dated 05.12.2018. Second appeal has been received in the Commission on 14.02.2019.

On the last date of hearing, held on 24.02.2020, the respondent PIO was directed to send the requisite information to the appellant through registered post within a week from that day and the appellant was advised to point out deficiencies in the information supplied with a copy to the Commission.

Sh. Amanveer Singh, Traffic Manager-cum-PIO, who appeared in person in today's hearing, states that the requisite information, as per queries raised through RTI request, has already been supplied to the appellant vide letter no. 1327 dated 10.05.2019 and again vide letter no. 7952 dated 21.11.2019. He also states that a reply has also been sent to the Commission vide letter no. 5442 dated 01.12.2020, which has been received in the Commission vide Diary No. 17915 dated 07.12.2020.
