ORDER

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 23.10.2020.

2. The appellant states that no information has been provided by the respondents so far. On the other hand, the representative of the respondents states that the case may be adjourned and the complete information will be supplied to the appellant.

3. After the perusal of the case file it has transpired that the show cause notice was issued to Sh. Sarabjeet Singh Brar,7009019165 Public Information Officer-cum-Block Development and Panchayats Officer but neither the information has been supplied by him nor a reply of the show cause notice issued to him has been received. The perusal of the file also shows that in this case, application for information was filed on 16.03.2020 but after lapse of more than eight months, no information has been given to the appellant so far. It is, thus apparent from the response of the respondent-PIO that there has been delay in providing the information. Appellant had also suffered financial loss in getting the information. There are systemic deficiencies in the manner of receiving and disposing of applications. The department still does not appear to be properly tuned to the performance of its obligations enshrined under the RTI Act.

5. I am, therefore, of the view that ends of justice would be met by awarding a sum of Rs. 10000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) by way of compensation to the appellant. This amount shall be payable in the shape of demand draft from the State Exchequer before the next date of hearing.

6. The respondent-Public Information Officer is also directed to supply the complete information before the next date of hearing failing which the penalty provisions will be invoked.
