ORDER

The RTI application is dated 21.01.2019 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter called FAA) on 18.03.2019 and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 13.05.2019 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter called RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for today.

2. The appellant is absent but he has sent an email stating that he has not received any information till date and sought exemption from appearance. He further stated that another opportunity be given to him for defending his case.

ਉਪਰੋਕਤ ਵਿਸ਼ੇ ਦੇ ਸੰਬੰਧ ਵਿਚ ਬੇਨਤੀ ਕੀਤੀ ਜਾਂਦੀ ਹੈ ਕਿ ਉਪਰੋਕਤ ਵਿਸ਼ੇ ਤੇ ਬਿਨੈਕਾਰ ਪਾਸੋਂ ਜਿਸ ਸੂਚਨਾ ਦੀ ਮੰਗ ਕੀਤੀ ਗਈ ਹੈ, ਉਸ ਵਿਚ ਅਲਾਟ ਹੋਏ ਰਕਬੇ ਦਾ ਕੰਨਵੇਅੰਸ ਡੀਡ (Conveyance Deed) ਨੰਬਰ ਅਤੇ ਕੋਈ ਗੋਸ਼ਵਾਰਾ ਨੰਬਰ ਨਹੀਂ ਦਸਿਆ ਗਿਆ। ਇਸ ਸੰਬੰਧੀ ਬਿਨੈਕਾਰ ਨੂੰ ਸੂਚਿਤ ਕਰਨ ਉਪਰੰਤ ਲੋੜੀਂਦੀ ਸੂਚਨਾ ਪ੍ਰਾਪਤ ਕਰਕੇ ਅਤੇ ਦਫ਼ਤਰ ਵਿਚ ਉਪਲਬਧ ਰਿਕਾਰਡ ਮੁਤਾਬਿਕ ਦੇ ਦਿਤੀ ਜਾਵੇ। ਇਸ ਸੰਬੰਧੀ ਮਾਨਯੋਗ ਚੀਫ਼ ਇਨਫਰਮੇਸ਼ਨ ਕਮਿਸ਼ਨਰ ਪੰਜਾਬ ਜੀ ਨੂੰ ਵੀ ਸੂਚਨਾ ਭੇਜ ਦਿਤੀ ਜਾਵੇ।

4. The appellant is advised to visit the office of Tehsildar, Ludhiana (East) with conveyance deed number alongwith goshwara numbers etc. to the PIO and get the information from the PIO of the concerned office within ten days. PIO/Tehsildar, Ludhiana (East) is directed to provide the information to the appellant, if he gives specific details regarding conveyance deed number and goshwara number etc. under the provisions of the Right to Information Act, 2005. He is further directed to send intimation regarding supply of information to the Commission through e-mail.

5. The case is adjourned to **26.08.2019** at **3.30 P.M.** through Video Conference facility available in the office of the Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana.
