ORDER

1. The RTI application is dated 23.01.2021 whereby the information-seeker has sought information as mentioned in his RTI application. He filed complaint in the Commission on 03.03.2021 under Section 18 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
2. Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 08.06.2021 i.e. today.
3. The complainant Sh. Sandeep Pathak states that no information has been given to him so far.
4. The respondent states that he has sent their reply to the Commission office vide no. 10579 dated 27.05.2021.
5. After hearing both the parties and examining the case file, it is observed that the respondent has sent his reply to the Commission office, which was received in the Commission vide diary no. 11563 dated 27.05.2021. The same is as under:-

It is submitted that application ref. No. RTIN/SP/000111, dated 23.01.2021, addressed to the PIO o/o Director General of Police, Punjab was received in this office. On examining the application, it was observed that the information sought by the applicant could not be provided to him, as the same relates to the subject of security and Security Wing of Punjab Police has been kept out of the purview of the Right to Information Act-2005. Accordingly, a reply was sent to the applicant vide letter No.6221/DDSB-5, dated 18.03.2021, through the SSP, Bathinda. Acknowledgement receipt of the same sent by the SSP, Bathinda is enclosed herewith.

The applicant filed an appeal before the First Appellate Authority vide letter dated 24.02.2021, which was duly considered by the First Appellate Authority-Cum, IGP/Security, Punjab and it was decided that the requisite information sought by the applicant could not be provided to him, due to the reason that vide Govt. Notification No. S.O.49/C.A.22 /2005/ S.24/2016 dated 07.06.2016, the Security Wing of Punjab Police has been exempted from the purview of Right to Information Act- 2005.

4. In view of the above the reply filed by the respondent appears to be convincing, hence, no cause of action is left. Hence, the complaint case filed by the complainant is disposed of and closed. Copy of the order be sent to the parties.
