ORDER:

The appellant through RTI application dated 27.01.2020 has sought information on 09 points regarding the resolution of MC, estimates, tenders invited and submitted, work permit released for laying 300 ft sewage lane and street on Sekhon street on College road, contractors/persons involved in laying the street, letter of permission and other information concerning the office of Director, Local Govt. Department, Pb Chandigarh. The appellant was not provided with the information after which the appellant filed first appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 30.01.2020 which took no decision on the appeal. The appellant had filed an appeal under Life & Liberty. However, as per the order of the Hon'ble CIC, the case is being considered under general category.
