

### **Heard through Video Conferencing**

- 1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 03.06.2020 passed by this Bench on the previous date of hearing.
- 2. The case has been heard today through V.C. at DC Office, Sangrur. The appellant Shri Ravi Kumar comes present and states that in spite of the directions of Commission on the previous hearing, no information has been supplied to him.
- 3. Neither the PIO himself has come present to attend the hearing through VC nor he has deputed any official to attend the hearing on his behalf. The Bench observes that the directions given by the Commission have also not been complied with. The Commission takes serious note of the absence of PIO.
- 4. The PIO O/o Secretary, R.T.A. Sangrur is issued show cause notice to explain his absence and to explain as to why action should not be taken against him and also as to why penalty should not be imposed in the instant case for the delay caused in the supply of information to the appellant and for not attending the hearing. He is also directed to file a written reply to the show cause notice as to why the appellant should not be compensated for the mental harassment suffered by him in getting the information.

5. In addition to the written reply, PIO is hereby given an opportunity u/s 20(1)

proviso thereto for a personal hearing before the imposition of such a penalty, on the next

date of hearing. He may take note that in case he does not file the written reply and does not

avail himself of the opportunity of personal hearing on the next date fixed, it will be presumed

that he has nothing to say and the Commission shall proceed to take further proceeding

against him ex-parte.

6. The PIO is also directed to call the appellant to his office on any working

day prior to next hearing and allow him to inspect the official records and identify the

documents as per his RTI application. The PIO is further directed to share the link of the

official website with the appellant and also to provide the hard copy of the information so

identified by the appellant failing which the penal consequences shall follow.

7. With the above directions, the matter is adjourned. **To come up for hearing** 

on 25.08.2020 at 11.30 AM through V.C. in the office of D.C. Sangrur. Copies of the

orders be sent to the parties concerned.

- 1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 03.06.2020 passed by the Bench on the last date of hearing.
- 2. The appellant comes present to attend the hearing through V.C. in the office of D.C. Bathinda. He states that the information as asked for vide his RTI application has not been provided to him and misleading and irrelevant information has been provided.
- 3. Smt. Saroj Rani, District Revenue Officer, O/o D.C. Bathinda/PIO comes present to attend the hearing. She states that with regard to the land scam referred to by the appellant in his RTI application in Nagar Panchayat, Mehraj (Bathinda), two different enquiries were got conducted by the D.C. Bathinda and after completion of enquiries reports in both the enquiries have been received and the enquiry reports have been sent by registered post to the appellant vide letter dated 02.07.2020.
- 4. The appellant is not satisfied with the enquiry reports and states that as per his RTI application, he wants to know the action taken on the guilty persons found in the enquiry reports regarding the land scam.

5. On the asking of the Bench, the PIO states that as per the enquiry report, no person has been found guilty and she further reads out excerpts from the enquiry report to substantiate this.

- 6. The Bench, on hearing the version of the PIO, directs the PIO to file an affidavit duly signed by the PIO and attested by the Notary Public to the effect that the information sought vide RTI application in AC No.4051/2019 i.e. enquiry report conducted into the complaint submitted by the appellant regarding the land scam in Nagar Panchayat, Mehraj, have been supplied to the appellant. Information supplied is complete & authentic. Nothing has been concealed therein.

- 1. The order may be read with reference to the order dated 03.06.2020 passed by the Bench on the previous date of hearing.
- 2. The case has been heard today through V.C. at Hoshiarpur. The complainant is absent. As such, he was contacted on phone to enquire the position regarding receipt of information by him. He has informed the Bench on phone that he has not received any information. He further states that as per directions of Commission, he had again submitted a copy of his RTI application to the office of the PIO.
- 3. None has appeared on behalf of the PIO. On perusing the file, the Bench observes that the Complaint filed by the complainant is dated 14.11.2018 and appeal filed in the Commission is dated 05.11.2019, but in spite of the lapse of a long period, the complainant has not been provided any information. The Bench further observes that PIO has been absent from hearing on the previous four consecutive hearings and is absent for today's hearing also. As such, a contact was made with the District Education Officer (Sec. Edu.), Hoshiarpur. He is informed about the absence of the PIO on all the hearings including the
