parte. A copy of this order be sent to him through registered post with the directions to supply the
certified copies of the required information to the appellant as per queries raised by him through
RTI request with a copy to the Commission.

An opportunity is also given to the appellant to confirm whether he has received
the information or not.

As I am demitting the office on 23rd September, 2022 and I have left with little time
to decide the issues, which have been cropped in the instant appeal case, hence, next date of
hearing in this case can not be fixed before the Bench of the under-signed.

Accordingly, this case-file be sent to the Deputy Registrar to place this case file
before the Hon'ble Chief Information Commissioner for appropriate orders to fix further
hearing/hearings in the instant appeal-case .

Copies of the orders be sent to the parties.
