


- 1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 21.07.2020 passed by this Bench on the previous date of hearing.

- 1. The RTI application is dated 13.06.2020 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. Complaint was filed in the Commission on 21.07.2020 under Section 18 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 08.09.2020 by the Commission through Video Conferencing facility in the office of D.C. Ludhiana.
- 3. The case has been heard today through V.C. in DC Office, Ludhiana. Shri Parkash Singh Chugh, complainant comes present to attend the hearing. He states that he has not received any information.
- 4. Shri Piara Singh, PIO comes present and states that the complainant has sought information regarding the action taken on complaints made against Shri Ravinder Singh, Clerk working in office of Secretary, R.T.A. Ludhiana.
- 5. From perusal of the record as available on the file, it is ascertained that the complainant has not availed the provision of the Section 19(1) of the RTI Act by filing an appeal with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). As such the FAA has not been able to address the grievances of the complainant.
- 6. It must be noted that there is an alternate and efficacious remedy of First Appeal available under Section 19(1) of the RTI Act. It appears that the complainant has failed to avail the same in the instant case.

- 7. In view of the aforesaid, the instant matter is remanded to the First Appellate Authority. The Commission hereby directs the FAA to treat the copy of the Complaint (enclosed herewith) as the First Appeal and decide the matter in accordance with the provisions of the RTI Act after giving all concerned parties an opportunity to be heard. In case, the complainant is not satisfied with the decision of the First Appellate Authority (FAA), he is at liberty to file second appeal with Punjab State Information Commission in accordance with the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.

- 1. The RTI application is dated 09.06.2020 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. Complaint was filed in the Commission on 21.07.2020 under Section 18 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 08.09.2020 by the Commission through Video Conferencing facility in the office of D.C. Ludhiana.
- 3. The case has been heard today through V.C. in DC Office, Ludhiana. Shri Parkash Singh Chugh, complainant comes present to attend the hearing. He states that he has received information vide letter dated 30.06.2020 which is not satisfactory.
- 4. Neither the PIO has come present nor has any official been deputed to attend the hearing on his behalf.
- 5. On perusal of case file, the Bench observes that the information asked for by the complainant relates to two employees of Municipal Corporation and the same has not been provided to the complainant being personal information. It is further ascertained that the complainant has not availed the provision of the Section 19(1) of the RTI Act by filing an appeal with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). As such the FAA has not been able to address the grievances of the complainant.

6. It must be noted that there is an alternate and efficacious remedy of First Appeal available under Section 19(1) of the RTI Act. It appears that the complainant has failed to avail the same in the instant appeal case.

- 7. In view of the aforesaid, the instant matter is remanded to the First Appellate Authority. The Commission hereby directs the FAA to treat the copy of the Complaint (enclosed herewith) as the First Appeal and decide the matter in accordance with the provisions of the RTI Act after giving all concerned parties an opportunity to be heard. In case, the complainant is not satisfied with the decision of the First Appellate Authority (FAA), he is at liberty to file second appeal with Punjab State Information Commission in accordance with the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.
- 8. In view of the above, **the case is disposed off and closed.** Copy of the order be sent to the parties.
