ORDER

1. The Appellant/Complainant filed appeal/complaint case in the Commission dated 05.01.2021. Accordingly, the case is fixed for today.
2. Respondent, Sh. Lakhvinder Singh pleaded that a reply pertaining to the sought information enumerated in the RTI application has been sent to the appellant vide letter reference no. 177 dated 12.10.2020.
3. Appellant, Sh. Jasvir Singh stated that he is not satisfied with the said reply of respondent-Public Information Officer.
4. The appellant is directed to avail of the said offer within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of the letter of inspection from the respondent authority, without fail.
