She also intimates the Commission that a reply has also been sent to the Commission vide letter no. 1289 dated 21.12.2021, which has been received in the Commission through an e-mail. It is taken on record.

The appellant, Sh. Surjit Singh, who appeared in person in today's hearing, states that the information given to him by the respondent PIO is not satisfactory, moreover, not as per queries raised by him through RTI request.

After examining the RTI request placed in the case-file, it is found that the appellant has demanded copy of seniority list through which promotions have been done and copy of case-file carrying record of pay fixation of promoted employees and copy of his (appellant) service book.

Nevertheless, an opportunity is given to the respondent PIO concerned to bring a copy of the information (which was already supplied to the appellant) with the relevant official record (as per queries raised through RTI request) in the office of State Information Commission, Punjab, before the bench of the undersigned on the next date of hearing fixed so that facts of this case could be cleared.

The case is <u>adjourned to 23rd March, 2022 (Wednesday) at 11:00 A. M. for hearing in Court Room office of State Information Commission, Punjab, Red Cross Building, Madhya Marg, Sector 16, Chandigarh.</u>
