

- 7. With the above directions, the matter is adjourned. The PIO is directed to come in person on the next date of hearing on 14.07.2020 at 11.30 AM thorugh V.C. in the office of D.C. Ludhiana. Copies of the order be sent to the parties concerned.

ORDER

- 1. The RTI application is dated 03.10.2019 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 25.11.2019 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 26.02.2020 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 09.06.2020 by the Commission through Video Conferencing facility in the office of D.C. Ludhiana.
- 3. The case has been heard through V.C. at DC Office, Ludhiana. Shri Baljeet Singh, appellant comes present. He states that he has not been supplied any information by the PIO.
- 4. Neither the PIO himself has come present nor he has deputed any of his representatives to attend the hearing nor has supplied any information to the appellant. The Bench takes serious note of these issues.
- 5. The PIO O/o Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Zone-D, Ludhiana is issued show cause notice to explain his absence and to explain as to why action should not be taken against him and also as to why penalty should not be imposed in the instant case for the inordinate delay in supply of information to the appellant. He is also directed to file a written reply to the show cause notice as to why the appellant should not be compensated for the mental harassment suffered by him in getting the information.

- 6. In addition to the written reply, PIO is hereby given an opportunity u/s 20(1) proviso thereto for a personal hearing before the imposition of such a penalty, on the next date of hearing. He may take note that in case he does not file the written reply and does not avail himself of the opportunity of personal hearing on the next date fixed, it will be presumed that he has nothing to say and the Commission shall proceed to take further proceeding against him ex-parte.
- 7. The PIO is directed to come in person on the next date of hearing. He is also given another opportunity to supply the complete information to the appellant failing which the penal consequences shall follow.
- 8. With the above directions, the matter is adjourned. To come up for hearing on 14.07.2020 at 11.30 AM through V.C. in the office of D.C. Ludhiana. Copies of the order be given to the concerned parties.
