O R D E R

Smt. Kiran Sharma, complainant/applicant filed RTI application dated 18.03.2019 and sought some information from the SPIO-cum-Head Incharge, P. S., Dugri, Ludhiana.

Today the case is heard through CISCO Webex Meetings Software. Shri Sushil Kumar is present on behalf of the applicant and ASI Dilbagh Singh is present on behalf of the SPIO. The representative of the complainant/applicant stated that the sought for information has not been provided to the complainant/applicant by the SPIO.

The respondent stated that the complainant/applicant has sought same information earlier also and regarding that the copy of FIR and copy of the Chemical Examiner Report of Juhi Sharma, daughter of the complainant/applicant has been provided to her.

The Commission has received an e-mail sent by the PIO, which is a copy of Report by ASI Dilbagh Singh, copy of FIR No.0213 dated 24.09.2018, copy of Report of the Chemical Examiner of Ms. Juhi Sharma and copy of FIR No.0076 dated 31.05.2019.

I have gone through the Report by ASI Dilbagh Singh and it is submitted in the report that the complainant/applicant has sought same information earlier also and regarding that the copy of FIR and copy of the Chemical Examiner Report of Juhi Sharma, daughter of the complainant/applicant received from the Govt. Laboratory Kharar, Punjab has been provided to her. It is further submitted that Ms. Juhi Sharma had registered FIR No.76 dated 31.05.2019 U/s 376, 120B IPC at Police Station, Shimlapuri, Ludhiana against her mother Smt. Kiran Sharma and Shri Sushil Kumar. It is again submitted that the applicant has sought information through seven points, but there is no information available in the office of the PIO regarding those points and the information which was available in the office i.e. copy of FIR and copy of Chemical Examiner Report of Juhi Sharma has already been provided to the complainant/applicant.

In the light of the above said facts that the information which was available in the office of the PIO i.e. copy of FIR and copy of Chemical Examiner Report of Juhi Sharma has already been provided to the complainant/applicant, so the present complaint case is **disposed of and closed.**
