ORDER

First Appellate Authority: O/o DIG, Ludhiana Range,

The present appeal case was earlier heard by the Hon'ble State Information Commissioner, Shri Asit Jolly and vide Order dated 13.02.2020 the case was referred to the Hon'ble Chief Information Commissioner for reassignment the case to some other Bench or Double Bench.

The Hon; ble Chief Information Commissioner vide Order dated 25.02.2020, constituted a Division Bench consisting of the present Bench and Hon'ble State Information Commissioner, Shri Sanjiv Garg. Notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today.

Today the case is heard through CISCO Webex Meetings Software.

Both the parties are present today.

We have perused the case file. Shri Ramandeep Singh Ahluwalia, appellant filed RTI application on 29.04.2019 and when no information was provided to him by the PIO, then he filed First Appeal before the First Appellate Authority and then Second Appeal before the Punjab State Information Commission. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench of the Hon'ble State Information Commissioner, Shri Asit Jolly and during the course of hearing vide Order dated 20.12.2019, Ld. Shri Asit Jolly imposed a penalty of Rs.5,000/- upon the PIO, Shri Vinod Kumar, Inspector, S.H.O. (City-2), Punjab Police, G.T. Road, Khanna and directed that the amount of penalty be deducted from his salary and be deposited in the Govt. treasury. In compliance to the Order of the Commission he has deposited the amount of penalty of Rs.5,000/- in the Govt. treasury vide Challan No. 00032461002202009964 dated 10.02.2020.

Appeal Case No. 3128 of 2019

Inspector Vinod Kumar filed a representation dated 21.01.2020, which was

received in the office of the Commission on 21.01.2020, diarized vide no.1418 and he requested

that the amount of penalty be waived off as he is not responsible for the delay in providing the

information to the appellant.

We have gone through the case file. It is clear that the RTI application was filed

on 29.04.2019 and as per the representation filed by Inspector Vinod Kumar, he took charge as

PIO-cum-SHO, Police Station, City-II, Khanna on 09.08.2019 and he remained there up to

21.12.2019. It means he remained as PIO-cum-SHO, Police Station, City-II, Khanna for 130

days. Though he was not the PIO-cum-SHO at the time when the RTI application was filed, but

in a continuity of responsibility when he took charge as SHO then he was responsible.

Secondly he submitted in his representation that the concerned file was marked

to SI Balwant Singh, Addl. SHO, P.S. City-II, Khanna and he did not took any action. This

contention of Inspector Vinod Kumar does not have any force because he was the

administrative head of the concerned Police Station and it was his administrative duty to get the

work done from his subordinates.

So, we are of the view that as Inspector Vinod Kumar remained PIO-cum-SHO,

Police Station, City-II, Khanna for 130 days, so he has rightly been penalized by the Bench of

Hon'ble State Information Commissioner, Shri Asit Jolly vide Order dated 20.12.2019. Moreover

Ld. Shri Asit Jolly has already taken a lenient view and a penalty of Rs.5,000/- only was

imposed upon Inspector Vinod Kumar.

Shri Ramandeep Singh Ahluwalia, appellant stated that he has received the

complete sought for information and he is satisfied with the information.

As the complete sought for information has been provided to the appellant and

the appellant is satisfied with the information and the amount of penalty of Rs.5,000/- has also

been deposited in the Govt. treasury by the concerned PIO, hence the present appeal case is

disposed of and closed.
