ORDER

Shri Jasbir Singh, appellant filed RTI application dated 10.08.2019 and sought
some information from the office of the SPIO.

Today the case is heard through CISCO Webex Meetings Software.

The appellant is present and Dr. Manu, SPIO, O/o Civil Surgeon, Ludhiana is also
present.

The appellant stated that he has received the information, but the amount of
compensation of Rs.3,500/- has not been paid to him by the SPIO.

Dr. Manu, SPIO, O/o Civil Surgeon, Ludhiana has sent reply to the Show Cause
Notice vide letter no.1060 dated 06.08.2021. I have gone through the said reply and also heard
the SPIO. It is submitted in the reply by the SPIO that the appellant has filed RTI application
dated 10.08.2019 before the Director, Health & Family Welfare, PB. The RTI application was
transferred to the office of the Joint Commissioner, Food and Drug Chemical Lab, Kharar vide
letter dated 26.08.2019. She further submitted that the RTI application was further transferred
to this office after a period of one year i.e. on 20.08.2020 which was received by this office vide
receipt No. 1429 dated 01.09.2020. It is further submitted by the SPIO that as the application of
the appellant received late by the concerned office, so the delay is not intentional and requested
to drop the Show Cause Notice.

So, after going through the reply to the Show Cause Notice and after giving
personal hearing to the SPIO, it is clear that the SPIO is not personally liable for the delay in
providing the information to the appellant. Hence, the Show Cause Notice issued to the SPIO is
hereby dropped and filed.

Appeal Case No. 1318 of 2020

Dr. Manu, SPIO, O/o Civil Surgeon, Ludhiana further requested that as the RTI application of the appellant has received late on 20.08.2020 in her office, so the amount of compensation of Rs.3,500/- be also waived off.

As per the reply of the SPIO that the RTI application of the appellant has received late on 20.08.2020 in her office, so there is no delay on the part of the SPIO in providing the information to the appellant. Hence the amount of compensation of Rs.3,500/- awarded in favour of the appellant, Shri Jasbir Singh is hereby waived off.

As the sought for information has been provided to the appellant by the SPIO, so the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed**.
