ORDER

Heard through facility of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings'.

The RTI request is dated 10.09.2019. First appeal is dated 04.10.2019. Second appeal has been received in the Commission on 07.02.2020.

On the last date of hearing, held on 16.12.2020,

- i) Sh. Akash Yadav, Advocate (representative of the appellant), stated that incomplete information was given and through a letter, deficiencies were pointed out to the respondent PIO.
- ii) The respondent PIO concerned was directed to facilitate the appellant or his representative to inspect the relevant official record on 23.12.2020 to identify the required information.
- iii) The appellant or his representative was advised to visit the office of the respondent PIO to inspect the relevant official record on 23.12.2020 at 11:00 A. M to identify the information.
- iv) The respondent-PIO concerned was directed to supply the required information, which would be identified by the appellant after inspection, to him.
- v) An opportunity was also given to the appellant to confirm whether he has received the information or not.

Ms. Jasvinder Kaur, Superintendent, who appeared on behalf of the respondent PIO in today's hearing, states that complete information has been supplied to the appellant and the appellant has also given an acknowledgement of having received the requisite information. She also intimates the Commission that a reply has also been sent to the Commission vide letter no. 153 dated 27.01.2021, which has been received in the Commission vide Diary No. 2406 dated 01.02.2021, appended to which is a note dated 19.01.2021, signed by the appellant as an acknowledgement of having received the requisite information, through which he claimed that he is satisfied with the information supplied and asked for filing of his case. It, alongwith annexure, is taken on record.

The appellant, Sh. Harminder Singh, who appeared in person in today's hearing, orally states that he has received the requisite information.

Since complete information has been supplied by the respondent PIO and the appellant has also acknowledged that he has received the required information, hence, the case is announced as **disposed of and closed**.

Sh. Satnam Singh, S. I., who appeared on behalf of the respondent PIO in today's hearing, states that a reply has already been given to the complainant. He also intimates the Commission that a reply has also been sent to the Commission vide letter no. 239-41 dated 05.02.2021, appended to which is a reply dated 04.02.2021 in an affidavit, signed by Deputy Superintendent of Police (Head Quarter), District Tarn Taran.
