The Commission feels that the appellant who is a retired government official is aggrieved with the action of some officials taken by them in line of their duties. He should approach the competent authorities in the hierarchy in the administration to seek redressal rather than misusing the forum of RTI.

The appellant is absent. Seemingly, he has not much to say on the issue. The appeal is **disposed** accordingly with the caveat that the Deputy Registrar shall not entertain any communication sent by him on the subject of this appeal.
