ORDER

Shri Manpreet Singh, complainant/applicant filed this RTI application on 26.08.2020 and sought information from the SPIO, O/o BDPO, Block Khera, Distt. Fatehgarh Sahib **regarding the Gram Panchayat Naraina for the period 1.1.2013 to 21.12.2018, by way of the Works Register, Staff Register, Bills etc.,** as enumerated in his RTI application.

Today the case is heard through CISCO Webex Meetings Software. Both the parties are absent today.

I have gone through the Order dated 03.06.2021. Both the parties were absent on that date also, but Shri Rajinder Kumar, Panchayat Secretary, Gram Panchayat, Naraina, Block Khera, Distt. Fatehgarh Sahib has sent a mail to the Commission, which was a copy of letter written to Shri Manpreet Singh, applicant that the requisite information is in the custody of the Executive Engineer, Rural Development & Panchayats Department at Mohali and whenever the record will be received back, the information will be provided to him. So, the PIO was directed to retrieve the requisite information and provide the same to the applicant before the next date of hearing.

The applicant has filed RTI application on 26.08.2020 and sought information regarding the Gram Panchayat, Naraina, but as per the reply of the respondent the record of the concerned Gram Panchayat has been submitted with the office of the Executive Engineer, Rural Development & Panchayats Department at Mohali on 16.01.2020, so the respondent PIO is unable to provide the sought for information to the applicant.

A Show Cause Notice was issued to the PIO vide Order dated 28.04.2021 that why the sought for information has not been provided to the applicant within the stipulated period and the PIO was directed to file reply to the Show Cause Notice. But as per the reply of the respondent that the related record has been submitted with the office of the Executive Engineer, Rural Development & Panchayats Department at Mohali on 16.01.2020. So, the PIO is not personally and intentionally responsible for not providing the information to the applicant. Hence, the Show Cause Notice issued to the PIO is hereby dropped and filed.

Complaint Case No. 861 of 2020

The PIO is directed that whenever the record of Gram Panchayat, Naraina will be received back from the office of the Executive Engineer, Rural Development & Panchayats Department at Mohali, the attested copies of sought for information be sent to the applicant through registered post within 15 days and compliance report be sent back to the Commission. With this observation the present complaint case is **disposed of and closed**.
