ORDER:

- 1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 27.07.2022 passed by this Bench on the previous date of hearing.
- 2. The case has been heard today in Commission's office at Chandigarh. The Appellant has not come present to attend the hearing.
- 3. The PIO/Shri Sanjeev Uppal, Superintendent, Tehbazari Branch, Zone-C, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana attends the hearing through cisco webex. However, due to connectivity issues, he is contacted on mobile phone. He makes vague submissions about the information and status of files being found or not. On the asking of the Bench as to whether penalty has been deposited or not, he still replies in negative and he states that he is ascertaining the manner for the deposit of amount of penalty.
- 4. The Bench observes from the version of the PIO, Shri Sanjeev Uppal that since the previous hearing, there has been no progress in the compliance of directions of the Bench and the position still remains the same. It implies that the PIO has not bothered to make efforts to comply with the directions of the Bench. The statement of the PIO also seems to be very unreasonable which cannot be expected from PIO of the stature of Superintendent. In view of this, the Bench is left with no other alternative but to enhance the amount of penalty from Rs.10,000/-, as imposed vide order dated 31.05.2021, to Rs.15,000/-(Rupees Fifteen thousand only).






ORDER
