ORDER:

Vide RTI application dated 26.10.2020 the complainant has sought the following information from the PIO O/o the DEO(SE), Gurdaspur relating to Des Raj Sr.Secy. DAV School, Batala:-

1. Name , designation and date of joining of all teachers from 01.01.2004 to date.
2. From which year EPF is deducted give Name & designation of all teachers.
3. Name & designation of those teachers whose EPF is deducted from 01.01.2004 to date. Copy of attendance register and pay register be provided.
4. Provide the names of persons working as Librarian, copy of their qualification and attendance register from January 2013 to date.
5. Name of members of Management Committee from 01.01.2010.
6. What is total strength of children. How many children got 25% free admission. Provide the Name of children, their father & mother name, Admission NO. In register, attendance register
7. Can the rules of CBSE and PSEB be follow in the school, provide the information.
8. Provide list of names of principals, their qualification, experience certificate, working on the pattern of CBSE and PSEB
9. How many Buddy groups in the school. Buddy group children names, name of Nodal Officer be provided from 2018-2019.

When the information was not provided by the PIO, he filed complaint in the Commission on 28.01.2020.

2. The Complainant states that the information provided to her is incomplete.

The Respondent states that whatever information available in their record has already been supplied to the Complainant.

3. This is a Complaint Case. Therefore, at this juncture it is relevant to invite the attention of the complainant to the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India rendered on 12-12-2011 in Civil Appeal Nos. 10788 of 2011 (arising out of SLP © No. 32768-32769/2010) in para 31 whereof, it has been held that while entertaining a complaint case under Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, the Commissioners have no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for an access to the information. Since the complainant has approached the Commission under the provisions of Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, no directions for providing further information can be given by the Commission.

4. An alternative and efficacious remedy of first appeal is available to the complainant under Section 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 which has not been availed in the instant case. The complainant is advised to approach the first appellate authority in this behalf.

5. In view of the above, **the case is disposed of and closed.**

7. Can the rules of CBSE and PSEB be follow in the school, provide the information.
8. Name of drivers of school van/busses, copy of licenses – be provided.
9. Provide names of principals and teachers their qualification, experience certificate copies be provided.
10. How many Buddy groups in the school. Buddy group children names, name of Nodal Officer be provided.

When the information was not provided by the PIO, he filed complaint in the Commission on 28.01.2020.

2. The respondent orally states that the requisite information has already been provided to the complainant.

3. The Complainant is again absent from today's hearing. He was also absent on the last hearings dated 24.06.2020, 29.07.2020 and 16.09.2020. He is contacted over phone, who, in turn, states that he has received the requisite information and is satisfied with the same. He further requests the court to close the case.
