But the complainant stated that he has not received the sought for information from the office of the SPIO so far.

So the complainant-applicant is directed that in case he would feel some deficiencies in the information which was sent to him on 09.11.2020 then he should bring the deficiencies in writing to the notice of the SPIO within five days from the receipt of information and the SPIO is further directed that in case the complainant-applicant submits the list of deficiencies to his notice then he should send the attested copies of information regarding the deficiencies to the complainant-applicant within five days from the receipt of list of deficiencies.
