- 1. The RTI application is dated 26.02.2020 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 02.06.2020 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 03.09.2020 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 10.11.2020 by the Commission through Video Conferencing facility in the office of D.C. Ludhiana. Shri Munish Kumar Aadiya, appellant comes present to attend the hearing through V.C. He states that he has sought a copy of register in which the ownership of Property No.B-5-966/2 is entered as also the copy of document if any court case relating to this property is pending, as CC is written against this property number. The same has not been provided to him in spite of the fact that he has been called to office repeatedly.
- 3. Shri Satish Kumar, Supdt./PIO, Zone-A, M.C. Ludhiana attends the hearing through V.C. He states that copy of the relevant register has been sent to the appellant vide letter dated 07.10.2020 by speed post and again on 04.11.2020, with a copy to the Commission. The PIO further states that as per intimation given to the appellant, no detail regarding the court case relating to this property is available in their record.

4. On the asking of the Bench, the PIO states that CC is written in case of a complaint case against the number of a proeprty. He explains to the Bench that the said proeprty has been illegally transferred by grand parents of the appellant, due to which CC is written against that property.

Oriignal copy of the affidavit be sent to the appellant and photocopy of the same be sent to the Commission for record.


