I have gone through the Order dated 06.10.2020 and the SPIO was directed that he should file a duly attested affidavit submitting that the information which was available in the office of the SPIO and is related with the office of the SPIO had already been provided to the appellant and except that no other information is available in the office of public authority and send the affidavit to the Commission as well as to the appellant within 10 days through registered post.

In compliance to the Order dated 06.10.2020 passed by the Commission Dr. Amrinder Singh, SPIO has sent an affidavit dated 29.10.2020 duly attested by Notary Public, which is in the file of the Commission.

I have gone through the RTI application dated 21.02.2020. During the course of hearing the appellant replied that he has received the information regarding point nos.2, 3 and 6 of the RTI application and he is satisfied with the information, but rest of the information has not been supplied to him by the SPIO.

I have discussed point-wise sought for information with both the parties. The SPIO submitted that the information related with point no.1 of the RTI application was sent to

the appellant vide letter no.966 dated 14.05.2020 and the information related with point no.7 of the RTI application was sent to the appellant vide letter no.1161 dated 21.09.2020 by mentioning that total HIV tested children were 893 and only 3 children were found positive.

The information related with point nos.4 and 5 of the RTI application has been denied by the SPIO being the personal information U/s 8(1)(j) of the RTI Act, 2005 which cannot be disclosed as no larger public interest involves in providing the names of HIV positive children.

The information related with point nos.8 to 11 of the RTI application are not concerned or related with the office of the public authority, so no information exist in the office of the public authority and the appellant is advised that he should get the information from the concerned public authority by filing fresh RTI application.

With the observations made above the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed.**
