

- i) The appellant could not make himself audible during the proceedings of the instant appeal case due to technical fault in connection of network but through telephonic communication, he intimated the Commission that no information was supplied to him by the respondent PIO.

After examining the documents placed on record, it is found that a show-cause notice was issued vide orders dated 25.08.2021 with the directions to the concerned PIO to appear before the Commission personally but he did not visit the Commission to attend the hearing, moreover, the requisite information has not been supplied by the respondent PIO to the information seeker even after even after the directions were given by the Commission vide orders dated 25.08.2021, which reflects that he is trying to delay in supplying the required information to the information-seeker. The Commission took a serious view of this casual approach of the respondent PIO.
