**ORDER:**

1. This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 13.10.2022.
2. In today's hearing, representative of the appellant states that affidavit is still pending from the respondent PIO.
3. Respondent PIO is not present for today's hearing as per directions vide order dated 13.10.2022.
4. During the hearing, a call was made to the respondent, Sh. Jasveer Singh and he intimates that he is unable to attend today's hearing due to personal reasons. He also intimates that compensation cheque amounting Rs 5,000/- had already been supplied and a copy of the same is also been sent to the Commission via email dated 16.10.2022, which is received and taken on record. He also mentions that affidavit had already been sent to the appellant through registered post under intimation to the Commission via letter no. 652 dated 09.11.2022. He also intimates that copy of an affidavit is also sent to the Commission via an email dated 09.11.2022, which is received and taken on record.
5. After hearing both the parties and going through the documents placed on record, it is observed that respondent PIO had already been supplied information to the appellant via office letter no. 517 dated 08.08.2022 and as per respondent's version nothing is left to be supplied as per official record. Respondent PIO had already deposited the penalty amounting Rs. 10,000/- (mentioned in order dated 10.08.2022) and compensation amounting Rs. 5,000/- had also been paid via cheque number 030794 dated 15.10.2022.
6. I am of the considered view that submitted affidavit is found satisfactory. Therefore, no further cause of action is required. Hence, this instant appeal case is **disposed of & closed**. Copy of the order be sent to the parties.

**ORDER:**

1. The RTI application is dated 8.8.2021 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 24.11.2021 and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 16.8.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for hearing through CISCO WEBEX on 10.11.2022 i.e. today
2. In today's hearing, both the parties are absent in spite of registered post notices issued to him by the Commission, which show casual attitude towards the notice of the Commission as well as to the RTI Act, 2005, which is a sheer wastage of precious time and resources of the Commission.
