ORDER

1. The appellant filed appeal in the Commission dated 21.01.2019. Accordingly the case was fixed for hearing today.
2. Respondent, Ms. Anju Chaudhary handed over the requisite information to the appellant during the hearing. She submits a reply signed by her dated 03.06.2019 along with supporting documents, which are taken on record.
