So, the appellant is directed that he should deposit the amount of assessed fee except the labour charges of Patwari of Rs.1,57,632/- with the office of the PIO within 15 days and in case the appellant deposits the assessed fee in the office of the PIO, then the PIO should provide the sought for information to the appellant within 30 days from the deposit of the assessed fee.

With this observation the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed**.

The PIO is directed that the Compliance Report be sent back to the Commission.

But not satisfied he filed Second Appeal before Punjab State Information Commission on 14.12.2018. The case was registered and allocated to the Bench. Notice of hearing was issued to both the parties for today. Both the parties are present today.

I have gone through the RTI application dated 24.08.2018 and discussed the matter with both the parties.

The PIO is directed that information sought by the appellant regarding list of teaching and non-teaching staff along with their basic salary for the period of 2013-14 and 2018 upto 24.08.2018 be sent to the appellant through registered post within 10 days. In case, any information is not available in the office of the PIO, then he should submit duly attested affidavit that this part of information is not available in his office and he is unable to provide it to the appellant.

Appeal Case No. 4321 of 2018

The PIO should personally come present on the next date of hearing along with copy of information and copy of postal receipt. In case he would not come present then action will be taken against him under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.
