ORDER

1. This order may be read with earlier order dated 27.10.2021 wherein respondent, Sh. Dharminder stated that requisite information was earlier sent to the appellant through registered post on 07.10.2020 which was returned undelivered. He added that same was sent to the appellant twice on 04.11.2020 and 16.01.2021.

Respondent PIO was directed to send information once again to the appellant under intimation to the Commission. Appellant is advised to go through the supplied information and point out deficiency within ten days after receipt of information in writing to the respondent PIO with a copy to the Commission as per RTI application, failing which case will be decided on merit basis. Matter was adjourned for further hearing on 23.03.2022, which was not heard due to Gazette Holiday on account of Martyrdom Day of Shaheed-E-Azam Sardar Bhagat Singh Ji and fixed for today i.e. 11.05.2022. Notice for the same was sent to the parties through registered post.

2. In today's hearing, both the parties are absent without any intimation to the Commission, which shows irresponsible behavior of both the parties towards the Notice and Orders of the Commission, it only leads to wastage of the precious time and resources of the Commission. This attitude of the concerned parties also lingers on the disposal of the cases. It is also observed that no communication from the appellant regarding information, which is presumed that he does not want to pursue this case further.
3. In view of the observations noted above, the instant case is **disposed of**. Copies of this decision be sent to the parties.
