ORDER:

The appellant through an RTI application dated 03.09.2020 has sought information regarding a file relating to a letter dated 27.08.2019 of the Department of administrative reforms, alongwith complete noting and other information as enumerated in the RTI application, from the office of SDM Balachaur. ORDER:

The complainant through an RTI application dated 29.06.2021 has sought information regarding details of alcohol samples collected from the year 2015 – a copy of entry register – a copy of the receipt issued during sample collection – number of license to shops/contractors as enumerated in the RTI application concerning the office of DHO-O/o Civil Surgeon, Ludhiana. The complainant was not provided with the information after which the complainant filed a complaint in the Commission on 10.08.2021.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Ludhiana/ Amritsar./Ludhiana. The complainant is absent and vide email has informed that the PIO has not supplied the information.

As per the respondent, there are four Food Supply officer in Amritsar District and the information by all FSOs have been sent to the complainant directly. As per the respondent, total of 18 samples were collected and the reply was sent to the complainant on 10.09.2021 and again on 22.04.2022:

Having gone through the RTI application and the reply of the PIO, the following is concluded:

Point-1 - List provided
 Point-2 - Provided
 Point-3 - To be provided

Point-4 - No license issued, reply sent

Having gone through the record, the Commission observes that since this is a complainant case and the complainant has come to the Commission under the provision of Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005 in which no directions for providing further information can be given by the Commission.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its Order dated 12.12.2011 in Civil Appeal Nos.10787-10788 of 2011 (arising out of SLP No.32768-32769/2010) has held that while entertaining a complaint under Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, the Commissioners have no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for an access to the information.

Complaint Case No. 1039 of 2021

Since there is an alternative and efficacious remedy of first appeal available to the complainant under section 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 which has not been availed in the instant case and the First Appellate Authority has not had the occasion to review the decision of the PIO, as envisaged under the RTI Act by passing a detailed well reasoned speaking order.

If, however, the complainant does not feel satisfied with the decision of the First Appellate Authority, he/she will be at liberty to file a Second Appeal before the Commission under Section 19(3) of the RTI Act.,2005.

In view of the observations noted above, the instant case is remanded back to the concerned First Appellate Authority-cum-Civil Surgeon, Amritsar with a copy of the RTI application for their ready reference and is also directed to call the complainant within 15 days of the receipt of the order, provide the information/reply pertaining to this RTI application. A compliance report of the same be sent to the Commission.

With the above observation and order, the case is disposed of and closed.
