#### **Appeal Case No. 2472 of 2018**

#### ORDER

Shri Gurdeep Singh Dhingi, appellant filed RTI application dated 18.11.2017 and he sought some information from the office of the PIO.

The respondent submitted a letter No. 6946 dated 28.08.2018, which was sent to the Commission through mail and received on 31.08.2018 and diarized at 17864. I have gone through the above said letter. The letter is accompanied with a copy of letter No. 9023 dated 28.11.2017 which was written by the PIO to the appellant, Shri Gurdeep Singh Dhingi and through this letter the PIO wrote to the appellant that he should deposit Rs.63,452/- with the office of the PIO, as cost for providing the information to him.

I have asked the appellant that whether he has deposited the assessed fee of Rs. 63,452/- with the office of the PIO which was asked by the PIO to deposit through letter No. 9023 dated 28.11.2017 and the appellant replied that he has not deposited the fee which was asked by the PIO to deposit.

So, the present appeal case is disposed of with the observation that in case the appellant wants to get information which he sought through his RTI application dated 18.11.2017, then he should deposit the assessed fee of Rs. 63,452/- with the office of the PIO Contd..p2..

within 10 days and in case the appellant deposits the assessed fee with the office of the PIO, then the PIO should provide the attested copies of information to the appellant within 10 days

from the receipt of the assessed fee.

With this observation, the present appeal case is disposed of and closed.
