Under these circumstances the appellant is directed to visit the office of the SPIO tomorrow i.e. 12.11.2021 and the SPIO is further directed to provide the complete information to the appellant and send compliance to the Commission.

Shri Manjinder Kumar, appellant filed RTI application dated 11.01.2021 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o BDPO, Garhshankar, Distt. Hoshiarpur.
