Pritampal Singh pleaded that a updated reply pertaining to RTI application was sent to the appellant through registered post dated **09.11.2020** therein the estimated photocopying charges pertaining to the sought information had been mentioned (**total number of pages 2,632** amounting **Rs. 5,264**) and the appellant was asked to deposit . A letter dated 06.04.2021 vide diary no. 7921 from the respondent PIO is received by the Commission wherein the aforesaid statements of the respondent is stated in detail. This letter is taken on record with all supporting enclosures.
3. Appellant, Sh. Hartej Singh telephonically contended that he had **not deposited the amount and the respondent replied within the stipulated time period as per RTI act 2005.**
4. However, the Commission observes that the respondent's submission (i.e. aforementioned letter) is part of the record and cannot be wished away.
5. Keeping in view the facts of the case and the submissions made by both the parties, the Commission directs the concerned PIO, who holds the requested record, to bring the original record to the next hearing. **The appellant is also requested to ensure his presence at the hearing so that he can list the pages he wants copied.**

1. The Appellant/Complainant filed above mentioned appeal/complaint cases in the Commission dated 11.01.2021. Accordingly, the cases are fixed for today.
2. Appellant, Sh. Makhan Singh stated that no information has been supplied so far.
3. Respondent, Smt. Amandeep Kaur pleaded that a point wise reply pertaining to the sought information as enumerated in the RTI application has been supplied to the appellant dated 27.03.2021. A copy of the same is received in the Commission dated 30.03.2021 vide diary no. 7209. She further added that the **appellant files number of RTI application repetitively shows he is bent upon harassing the public authority without any concern for wastage of public time he causing by his repeated application and appeal.**
4. *The Commission observes that any repetition of a RTI application or adding one or two points to the already sought information via previous RTI application would cause waste of time and energy of the Public Authority and the Commission, Which is unreasonable as the appellant is already holding the information given to his earlier application. Therefore, the Commission advises the appellant, to restrain himself from abuse by repetition of a RTI application.*
5. In view of the above observations, the PIO is directed to provide an additional reply to the appellant on all of the points raised in the RTI application.

In case the partial information is not available in the office record then an undertaking/affidavit may be filled in this regard to the appellant with a copy to the Commission without fail.

4. ***A strict warning is issued to the concerned PIO for not providing any reply to the appellant within the timeline prescribed under the Act. The PIOs are warned to be careful with the timeline and refrain from delaying replies.***
