One opportunity was awarded to him to represent this case along with directions to supply the reply/information to the complainant. Copy of order dated 24.02.2021 was sent to the respondent PIO through **registered post.** Matter was adjourned for further hearing on 20.04.2021, which was not heard due to technical issues and adjourned for 09.06.2021.

4. On hearing held on 09.06.2021, both the parties were absent and matter was adjourned for further hearing on 11.08.2021 with the directions to represent this case , failing which case will be decided on merit basis.
5. On hearing held on 11.08.2021, respondent PIO was absent consecutively third time and a Show Cause notice was issued to him by name.
