On the last date of hearing, held on 11.01.2021, the respondent PIO concerned was directed to facilitate the appellant to inspect the relevant official record on 05.02.2021 at 11:00 A. M. so that he could identify the required information. The respondent-PIO concerned was directed to supply the required information, which would be identified by the appellant after inspection, to him.

Ms. Rajvir Kaur, Building Inspector, Zone – D, who appeared on behalf of the respondent PIO in today's hearing, states that the appellant has not visited the office on the fixed date i. e. 05.02.2021 to identify the required information. She also intimates the Commission that a reply has also been sent to the Commission vide letter no. 456 dated 22.02.2021, which has been received in the Commission vide Diary No. 4712 dated 02.03.2021. It is taken on record.

In today's hearing, Sh. Gurmej Lal, appeared on behalf of the appellant, Sh. Sarabjeet Singh Gill to represent the case despite the fact that several opportunities were given to the appellant (himself) to appear personally during the proceedings of the Court, hence, presence of Sh. Gurmej Lal in today's hearing is not acceptable.
