**ORDER**

Heard through facility of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings'.  
The RTI request is dated 11.12.2018. First appeal is dated 11.04.2019. Second appeal has been received in the Commission on 24.12.2019.

On the last date of hearing, held on 19.04.2021, due to technical fault in connection of network, proceedings of the instant appeal-case could not held and on the earlier hearing, held on 10.02.2021, Sh. Ajay Kumar, Building Inspector, Zone – A, stated that replies were given to the appellant vide letter no. 5282 dated 29.01.2019 and vide letter dated 17.07.2019.
