If the record is not traceable, the PIO is directed to conduct an enquiry into the matter by constituting a committee and submit a complete enquiry report which establishes that the record is missing and the responsibility has been fixed for the person under whose custody the record found missing.

The Commission observes that the PIO has clearly tried to deny the information. Regarding point 1, the RTI application should have been transferred to the PIO Civil Surgeon, Fazilka under section 6 (3), which the PIO has not done.

Regarding points 2 & 3 the Commission observes that while invoking section 8(h) of the RTI Act the PIO has denied the information without any speaking order that why section 8 (h) has been invoked. Further to that, the PIO has invoked section 11 without following due procedure.


Having gone through the RTI application I find that there is no part of the information that falls under the exempted category and hence the PIO is directed to provide the information regarding points 2 & 3 to the appellant within 15 days and send a copy to the Commission.

Regarding point-1, the PIO Civil Surgeon, Fazilka is impleaded and directed to provide the information within 15 days.

The PIO denied the information to the complainant vide letter dated 09.09.2020 stating that the information sought is creative and it cannot be provided. Thereafter the complainant filed a complaint in the Commission on 02.03.2021.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Amritsar. The complainant claims that the PIO has not supplied the information.

The respondent is absent without any legitimate reasons for the absence. The PIO has refused the information on grounds that it is 'creative information.' This is an absurd term to use, and prima facie it appears that the PIO has not applied his/her mind in understanding the scope of information required and has sent an arbitrary reply denying the information by claiming that it is creative. The Commission has taken a serious view of this and hereby directs the PIO to show cause why penalty be not imposed on him under Section 20 of the RTI Act 2005 for denial of information on flimsy grounds and not supplying the information within the statutorily prescribed period of time. He/she should file an affidavit in this regard. If there are other persons responsible for the delay in providing the information, the PIO is directed to inform such persons of the show cause and direct them to appear before the Commission along with the written replies.

To come up for further hearing on 08.11.2021 at 11.00 AM through video conference facility available in the office of Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar. The PIO to appear at Chandigarh.
