



#### ORDER

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 03.06.2019 vide which Sh. J.S. Rana was directed to file his reply of show cause notice issued to him.

2. Today neither the complainant nor the respondent is present. The perusal of the file shows that during the hearing dated 16.10.2018, a show cause notice was issued to Sh. Jai Singh Rana, Sr. Assistant. But till today he has failed to file his reply in response to the show cause notice, which shows that he has no respect for the orders of the Commission to be present, either himself or through his representative in the court.

4. In view of the defying attitude of Sh. Jai Singh Rana, Sr. Assistant, neither attending the court nor submitting any explanation for the show cause notice issued to him within the time schedule as prescribed under the RTI Act 2005, the court comes to a logical conclusion that it is a fit case for the imposition of penalty amounting to Rs. 25000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand only) on the PIO. Therefore, taking a lenient view, I impose a penalty of **Rs. 5000/- (Rs. Five thousand only) on Sh. Jai Singh Rana, Sr. Assistant**. The Drawing and Disbursing Officer of the office of DPI(Colleges) is directed to deduct the amount of penalty of Rs. 5000/- from the salary



of Sh. Jai Singh Rana, Sr. Assistant and deposited in the State Treasury in the following Head of

Account and to report its compliance to the Commission:-

### ORDER

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 31.07.2019

2. The Counsel for the Complainant states that no information has been provided to the complainant so far.

3. No one has appeared on behalf of the Respondent today. They were not present on the previous three hearings also.

4. After going through the file, it is observed that this is the complaint case. The attention of the Complainant is drawn to the decision of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India rendered on 12.12.2011 in Civil Appeal Nos. Nos.10787 – 10788 of 2011 (arising out of SLP © No.32768-32769/2010)- Chief Information Commissioner and another Vs. State of Manipur and another, in Para 31 whereof, it has been held that while entertaining a complaint case under Section 18 of the RTI Act , 2005, the Commissioners have no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for an access to the information which is as under:-

(31. We uphold the said contention and do not find any error in the impugned judgment of the High Court whereby it has been held that the Commissioner while entertaining a complaint under Section 18 of the said Act has no jurisdiction to pass an order providing for access to the information).

As such, since the complainant has approached the Commission under the provision of Section 18 of the RTI Act, 2005, no directions for providing further information can be given by the Commission.

5. Since there is an alternative and efficacious remedy of first appeal available to the Complainant under Section 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, which has not been availed in the instant case and the First Appellate Authority has not had the occasion to review the decision of the PIO, as envisaged under the RTI Act by passing a detailed well reasoned speaking order. In case the complainant has any grouse, he is advised to challenge the response of the PIO before the designated First Appellate Authority, as envisaged under Section 19(1) of the RTI Act, 2005, who will decide the matter in accordance with the provisions of the RTI Act within the prescribed time limit, after giving an opportunity of hearing to all concerned, by passing a speaking order.

6. If, however, the complainant does not feel satisfied with the decision of the First Appellate Authority , he will be at liberty to file a Second Appeal before the Commission under Section 19(3) of the RTI Act, 2005.

In view of the same, the Complaint case filed by the Complainant is disposed off and closed. Copy of the orders be sent to the parties.
