So, a compensation of Rs.5.000/- is awarded in favour of Shri Vikram, S/o Shri Balwinder Kumar to be paid from the funds of public authority by way of demand draft and be sent to Shri Vikram through registered post within 10 days along with attested copies of complete information and compliance be sent to the Commission accordingly. In case of non compliance of the Order of the Commission a Show Cause Notice U/s 20(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 will be issued to the SPIO on the next date of hearing and he will be penalized upto Rs.25,000/-, which will be deducted from his salary.

Shri Kulwinder Singh Gopi, appellant filed RTI application dated 01.09.2020 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o BDPO, Aur, Tehsil Banga, Distt. SBS Nagar.

The appellant is present today, whereas none has come present on behalf of the respondent SPIO. The appellant stated that complete information has not been provided to him by the SPIO till date.
