(Technical Services Wing), who appeared on behalf of the respondent PIO in today's hearing, submit a reply vide letter no. 1834 dated 10.10.2022, appended to which is a compliance report dated 28.09.2022 regarding disciplinary action against Sh. Parmod Kumar Nagrath, A. S. I. (under Section 20 (2) of the RTI Act) as directed vide orders 05.09.2022. It, alongwith annexure, is taken on record.

5. Since the orders dated 05.09.2022 passed by the Commission has been complied with, the case is announced as **disposed of and closed.**
