request through registered post with a copy to the Commission by next date of hearing.

An opportunity is also given to the appellant to confirm whether he has received
the information or not and also to point out deficiencies, if any, in the information supplied to
him, in writing, to the respondent PIO well in time so that the same could be removed by the
respondent concerned and also send a copy of the same to the Commission.

Nevertheless, a copy of the RTI request alongwith a copy of notice of hearing be sent again to the respondent PIO so that the certified copies of the required information could be supplied to the complainant as per queries raised by him through RTI request, if supplied then send a copy of the same (supplied information) to the to the Commission by the next date of hearing

An opportunity is also given to the complainant to confirm whether he has received the information or not and also to point out deficiencies, if any, in the information supplied to him, in writing, to the respondent PIO well in time so that the same could be removed by the respondent concerned and also send a copy of the same to the Commission.

Another opportunity is also given to both the parties to represent this case in person or through their representative on the next date fixed through facility of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings'

The case is adjourned to 29th August, 2022 (Monday) at 11:00 A. M. for hearing.
