Shri Nitin Kumar Garg, appellant filed RTI application dated 25.05.2020 and sought some information from the SPIO, O/o SMO, Gurdaspur.

Today the case is heard through CISCO Webex Facility.

Both the parties are present today.

The SPIO stated that the sought for information comprising of 120 pages was sent to the appellant through registered post on 25.06.2021.

The appellant stated that he has received the information comprising of 120 pages sent by the SPIO, but the information is still incomplete.

Under these circumstances, the appellant is directed to visit the office of the SPIO by co-coordinating with the SPIO and the SPIO-cum-SMO, Gurdaspur is directed to hear the appellant and provide him the remaining information and compliance be sent to the Commission accordingly. IN case of non compliance of the Order of the Commission, a Show Cause Notice U/s 20(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 will be issued to the SPIO on the next date of hearing.
