ORDER

I have gone through the Order dated 15.07.2019 passed by the Commission in the presence of both the parties.

A compensation of Rs. 8,000/- was awarded in the favour of Shri Joginder Pal Devgan, appellant, to be paid from the funds of public authority by way of Demand Draft and today the PIO has submitted a Demand Draft dated 08.08.2019 of Rs. 8,000/- in the name of Shri Joginder Pal Devgan, appellant from Account No. 181934001000451, which is handed over to the appellant.

Smt. Paramjit Kaur, PIO submitted copy of letter no. 2069 dated 09.08.2019 as reply to the Show Cause Notice, which is taken in the file of the Commission. I have gone through the said letter. It is submitted by the PIO that a lot of information has been provided to the appellant as was sought by him through his RTI application dated 18.08.2017. Approximately, 700 pages of attested copies of information were provided to the appellant regarding the cash book, proceeding register, bill vouchers, copies of statements and copies of work registers. It is further submitted in the reply that the record regarding CRF grant has not been provided to the appellant as the record is pending with the office of Deputy Director, Rural Development and Panchayat, Ferozepur in connection with some departmental inquiry and it is further submitted that whenever the record will be received back after the completion of the

inquiry by the Deputy Director, Ferozepur, the remaining information will be provided to the appellant.

A Show Cause Notice was issued to Smt. Paramjit Kaur PIO-cum-BDPO, Block Annadana at Moonak, Distt. Sangrur on 18.10.2018 that why the information has not been provided to the appellant and so why you may not be penalized and why the compensation may not be awarded to the appellant. The PIO has filed reply to the Show Cause Notice through letter no. 2069 dated 09.08.2019.

I have heard the PIO, Smt. Paramjit Kaur on the Show Cause Notice. The RTI application was filed on 18.08.2017 by the appellant Shri Joginder Pal Devgan. Smt. Paramjit Kaur submitted that she was not posted as BDPO at Block Anndana at Moonak at that time. Rather, she has joined as BDPO on 09.04.2018. She further submitted that she was not PIO when the RTI application was filed, rather, she has joined as BDPO after 8 months from the filing of the RTI application and after joining as BDPO she tried her best to provide the information to the appellant and provided about 700 pages of attested copies of information to the appellant after joining as BDPO. She further submitted before the Commission that in future she will remain vigilant and provide the information to the RTI applicated period. Moreover the compensation of Rs. 8,000/- was awarded to the appellant which has been paid to him through demand draft by the PIO.

As mentioned above, that Smt. Paramjit Kaur, PIO-cum-BDPO was not PIO when the RTI application dated 18.08.2017 was filed, rather, she joined as BDPO on 09.04.2018. So, she is not personally liable in the delay in providing the information to the appellant. Hence, the Show Cause Notice issued to her is dropped and filed.

The PIO-cum-BDPO is directed that remaining information regarding CRF grant be provided to the appellant after the receipt of the record from the office of Deputy Director, Ferozepur within 15 days from the receipt of record in the office of the PIO.

With this observation the present appeal case is disposed of and closed.

sought information regarding testimonials and documents submitted by the candidates to the authorities at the time of counseling through which they got public employment. So, the information cannot be denied U/s 8(1)(j) of the RTI Act, 2005 rather it should be provided as it is the case of employment and the purpose of the RTI Act is to bring transparency and accountability in the functioning of the public authorities.

The object of the RTI Act is to bring the transparency and accountability in the functioning of the Government instrumentalities. So, it is in the larger public interest that the applicant is seeking documents submitted by the candidates to the authorities at the time of counseling through which they got public employment.

So, I ordered the PIO to send the attested copies of documents submitted by the candidates whose names are given in the RTI application, to the appellant through registered post within 10 days and compliance report be sent back to the Commission.

With this observation the present appeal case is **disposed of and closed**.
