The complainant/applicant is absent today, whereas Shri Rajbir Singh, Dy. General Manager (HR), O/o Milkfed, Punjab is present and he stated that Milkfed/Verka does not come under the RTI Act, 2005. He further stated that the reply regarding this has also been sent to the Commission as compliance.

I have gone through the reply sent by the respondent and it is submitted that Milkfed/Verka does not come under the RTI Act, 2005 being an Apex cooperative society as per the order passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No. 9017 of 2013. It is further submitted that the State Information Commission Punjab has also corroborated while deciding a RTI appeal/complaint case no. 1363 and 1364 of 2016 related with the Ropar District Co-operative Milk Producers Union Limited.

As per the reply submitted by the respondent, the Milkfed/Verka does not come within the ambit of RTI Act, 2005 and is not a public authority as per the order passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No. 9017 of 2013. Hence, the present complaint does not lie and thus **disposed of and closed accordingly.**
