ORDER

(1) *That the P.I.O of the office of Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Sirhind was requested to supply information on 9th points specifically vide RTI application dated 05-03-2020 ("P-3"). but he failed to supply the desired information despite Reminder letter dated 12-07-2020 (ANNEXURE "P-2") and Enclst letter dated 31-08-2020 (ANNEXURE "P-3")*
(2) *That on failing to get the desired information an APPEAL u/s 19 of RTI Act, 2005 was filed before the 1st appellate cum Regional Deputy Director, Urban Local Bodies, Ludhiana vide appeal application dated 31-08-2020 (ANNEXURE "P-3") which was referred to be accepted by the addressee and it was returned to me as non-delivered by the postal authorities. Therefore, the same was again sent by Registered Post vide letter dated 03-10-2020 (ANNEXURE "P-4"). But till date absolutely no action has been taken either to hear the appeal or get the desired information supplied despite my letter Enclst. dated 14-10-2020 addressed to the PSIC for filing 2nd appeal.*
(3) *That on my personal contact, the P.I.O concerned supplied me an incomplete, wrong and evasive information vide letter No. 32 dated 30-11-2020 delivered to me on 18-11-2020.*
(4) *That the deficiencies in the information supplied by the*

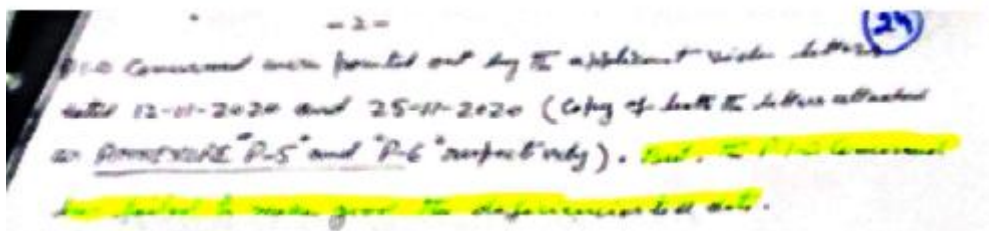

3. The appellant states that he had sought the information from the Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Sirhind and the case was heard by the bench of Sh. Hem Inder Singh and vide his order dated 16th March, 2021 the case has been disposed of on the basis of a wrong and totally false affidavit filed by the respondent-Public Information Officer, whereas the affidavit filed by the respondent Public Information Officer was incorrect. Furthermore, he states that now he has sought the information pertaining to the said case that is Appeal Case Number 3228 of 2020. He further states that the respondent Public Information Officer should have been penalised due to wrong affidavit but no action has been taken by the State Information Commissioner. However, the appellant was advised to inspect the said file i.e. Appeal Case No. 3228 of 2020 for the information sought in the titled case but the appellant does not agree with the same rather he requested that directions may be issued to the concerned bench to re-hear the said case.

4. Accordingly, the appellant may make the application to the concerned State Information Commissioner regarding re-hearing of the case along with the facts and figures that the respondent Public Information Officer has filed the wrong affidavit. Also a copy of this order is being sent to Shri Hem Inder Singh, State Information Commissioner to look into the matter in case any submissions are made by the appellant and also the case file is being sent to him along with this order. As far as this case is concerned the appellant was advised to inspect the file so that any information exist on record can be supplied with which the appellant does not agree with the same.

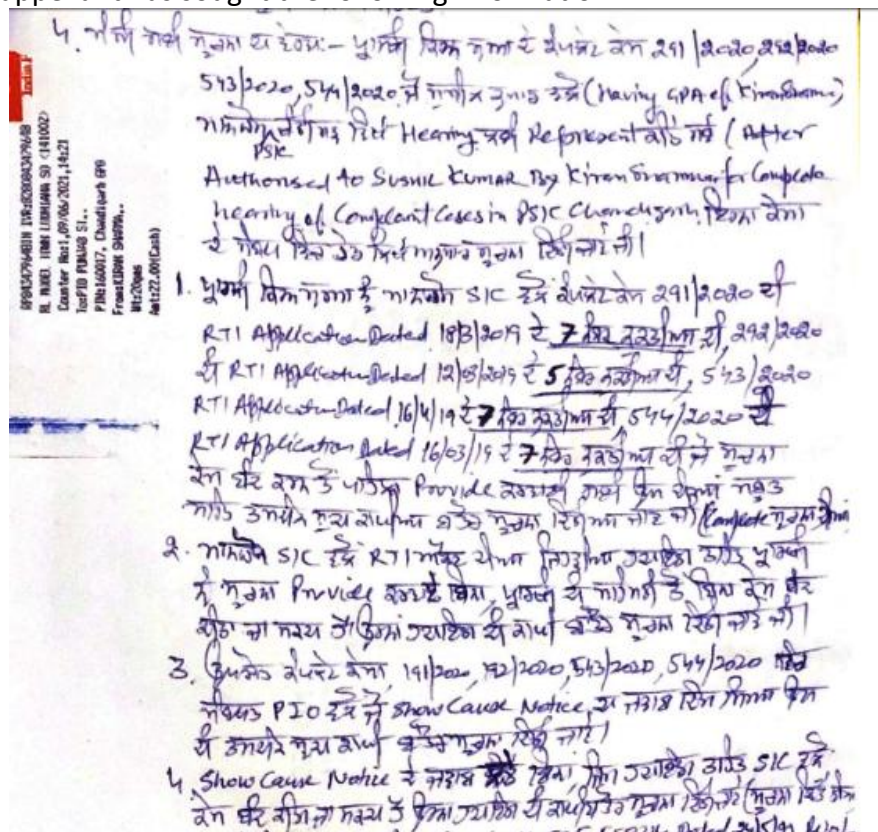

3. The appeal and states that he has sought to 4 point information with which he is not satisfied with the reply sent by the respondent-Public Information Officer. He also requested the point wise information as has been sought by him. However the representative of the respondent placed on record the copies of the case files related to the sought information bearing appeal case number 231/2020, 232/2020, 236/2020, 238/2020, 169/2021, 170/2021 and appeal case number 1041/2021 pertaining to Point No. 1 & 2 of the RTI application. Also the representative of the respondents clarified regarding Point No. 3 of the RTI application, i.e. the diary number on the emails sent to the bench of Sh. 3. The appellant has sought the action taken on the complaints filed by him to the Chief Minister, Punjab dated 24th February, 2020. However the response has already been received from the respondent Public Information Officer vide which it has informed that the appellant has already been apprised that his request has already been sent to the Department of Social Justice & Empowerment, Minorities Department. He has further informed that the appellant was also apprised that appellant may file the first appeal to the First Appellate Authority of the concerned department in case he is not satisfied with the information supplied by the said department but not to the Chief Minister's Office. However, the appellant insisted that the respondent Public Information Officer has to transfer the RTI application to the concerned department and requested that the said department may be impleaded as necessary party in this case with the directions to supply the information.

4. Since the appellant has sought the information from the Chief Minister's Office and the said office has already informed to the appellant that his request has already been sent to the Department of Social Justice & Empowerment, Minorities and also the appellant has been advised to file the RTI application to the concerned department and not to the Chief Minister's office as the request dated 24th February, 2020 has already been sent to the concerned department, action taken of which has been sought. Keeping in view the submissions made by the respondent Public Information Officer the Commission is of the view that no further action is required to be taken at the level of Chief Minister's Office and in case the appellant is interested to get the information from the Department of Social Justice & Empowerment, Minorities then he has to file the application afresh to the department concerned. Therefore, the case is disposed of and closed. A copy of the response filed by the respondent-Public Information Officer is being **sent** to the appellant along with this order.

3. After consideration of the submissions made by the respondent-Public Information Officer Sh. Dilbag Singh, the show cause notice issued to him is here by withdrawn.
