

ORDER:

The appellant through an RTI application dated 09.02.2021 has sought information on 05 points regarding a copy of the register maintained for recording entry of the receipt of complaints without number along with the name, address/police station from 01.01.2012 to 31.12.2012 and 01.06.2016 to 30.09.2016 – a copy of the register containing action taken on the complaints - details of record sent to police commissioner by police chowki/police station for enquiry on the complaints – permission to allow inspection and other information as enumerated in the RTI application from the office of DCP Amritsar. The appellant was not satisfied with the reply of the PIO dated 20.02.2021 stating that the information is not specific and has to be created, it cannot be provided. After which the appellant filed a first appeal before the first appellate authority on 27.02.2021 which took no decision on the appeal.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Amritsar. As per the appellant, the PIO has not supplied the information.

The respondent present pleaded that the RTI application was received by them on 11.02.2021 and the reply was sent to the appellant on 20.02.2021. The appellant was not satisfied with the reply and filed an application to the DGP Head Quarter. Since the DGP is not the first appellate authority, the office of the DGP marked the application to the Commissioner of Police Amritsar-cum- the appropriate first appellate authority on 09.03.2021, which was received by them on 16.03.2021. Thereafter, the Commissioner of Police Amritsar disposed the marked application with the remarks that the appellant has not specified the record to be inspected; the appellant may specify the same first.

From the above, it is clear that the appellant did not file the first appeal before the appropriate first appellate authority but merely wrote to the DGP office in a bid to seek directions from the top office to get the information that the appellant had provided insufficiently.

In lieu of the above, the case is remanded back to the First Appellate Authority-cum-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar with the direction to treat this as an appeal case and dispose it of within the stipulated period of 30 days, as per the RTI Act.
