This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 28.6.2022 vide which the representative of respondents sought adjournment for filing the reply. The case was adjourned accordingly and fixed for hearing today. The appellant has sought the following information:

A report, which claimed massive encroachments in Punjab since 1991, was submitted to the state government in June 2019. Before that, a two-member panel comprising former Judge SS Saron and ex-DGP Chander Shekhar submitted its report to a Cabinet sub-committee headed by then Urban Local Bodies Minister Navjot Singh Sidhu on March 27, 2019.

1. Please supply the certified copy of the report submitted in June 2019.

2. Please supply the certified copy of the report submitted by the two-member panel comprising former Judge SS Saron and ex-DGP Chander Shekhar which was submitted to a Cabinet sub-committee headed by then Urban Local Bodies Minister Navjot Singh Sidhu on March 27, 2019.

2. The appellant is absent today without any intimation to the Commission. The appellant was absent during the last three hearings i.e. 4.5.2022, 31.5.2022 and 28.6.2022. He was sent a copy of order through registered post intimating him the proceedings and next date of hearing.

3. The representative of the respondents submits that the sought information by the appellant is not available in the department. The PIO has sent a letter 2/8/2022/-4ss4/726 dated 12.7.2022 to the Commission which is taken on record.

4. That in CWP 30014-2017(O &M) decision given by the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court on 7.7.2022 also disposed of the case for non availability of the record.

5. In view of the above, no more cause of action is left in this case. Hence this case is disposed of and closed. A copy of letter so received from the PIO o/o Local Government, Punjab – Branch-4 is being sent to the appellant.
