the attitude in dealing with the RTI application a show cause notice was issued on 20.2.2020 to Sh. Parvinder Singh under Section 19(8)(b) of the RTI Act to compensate the appellant. Parvinder Singh, Public Information Officer is directed to pay an amount of Rs.5000/- via demand draft drawn through Government Treasury as compensation to the appellant for the loss and detriment suffered by him of having to file the appeals and not getting the information in time.
