Ludhiana was directed to deduct the amount of penalty of Rs.10,000/- from the salary of Shri Jagtar Singh, Panchayat Officer.

But neither the BDPO, Pakhowal has come present today nor he has sent any compliance report to the Commission.

So, the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Ludhiana is directed that he should deduct the amount of penalty of Rs. 10,000/- from the salary of Shri Jagtar Singh, former Panchayat Secretary of Gram Panchayat, Threeke, Distt. Ludhiana, now posted as Panchayat Officer, Block Pakhowal and receipt be sent to the Commission for compliance. The DDPO, Ludhiana will be personally responsible for the compliance of the Order.
