The appellant stated that in compliance to the Order dated 02.09.2021, he has visited the office of the SPIO on 06.09.2021, but incomplete information has been provided to him by the SPIO.

Under these circumstances, the appellant is directed to bring the deficiencies in writing to the notice of the SPIO within 2 days and the SPIO is further directed that in case the appellant would submit the deficiencies, then the attested copies of information regarding the deficiencies be provided to the appellant within 5 days from the receipt of deficiencies and compliance be sent to the Commission. In case of non compliance of the Order of the Commission a Show Cause Notice U/s 20(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 will be issued to the SPIO on the next date of hearing and a penalty of Rs. 25,000/- will be imposed upon the SPIO which will be deducted from his salary.
